The Center for the Arts & Sciences and Brazosport Center Stages provides high-quality enriching fine arts programs and theater to residents and visitors to our community. We play a big role in elevating the cultural landscape of southern Brazoria County. The COVID-19 pandemic caused the cancellation of several theatre productions and educational opportunities.

By utilizing beautiful outdoor public amenities in both Clute and Lake Jackson, developing safety plans for audiences, and by selecting plays that allow for social distancing of the volunteer actors while keeping the artistic integrity of each play, we hope to offer an evening out for audience members who may be hesitant to purchase a ticket and watch a play indoors.

It has been The Center for the Arts & Sciences and Brazosport Center Stages' ambition to find opportunities to get our art into public spaces. A successful production will result in expanding this program into future outreach performances. We hope to cultivate fine arts and theatre appreciation within our community and to enhance the quality of life for our friends and neighbors.
